MONEY SPENT LAST TERM BY THE SCHOOL

As you are aware, the Key Stage 2 hall is now fitted with a new projector and sound system which cost us just under £7,000. Staff tell me it has transformed not only assemblies but also PE lessons. Due to the success of this system, we have agreed to pay for a similar system in the Key Stage 1 hall. All being well, this should be installed during half term – watch this space!

As well as the projector, last term we spent £209 updating some of our Mini Youth games kit. We bought new bags printed with the Fairview logo, new shorts, socks and shin pads and paid for the school name to be printed on some existing kit that we owned.





£1560 was requested to replace both out-of-date atlases and dictionaries across the school, and we have spent £650 on new PE equipment. You may have noticed the new netball posts in the KS2 playground. £750 has been used to put playground markings on the playground at the back of the school, including a full size netball court. Further markings are to follow on other playgrounds once the weather improves. We provided each child with a Christmas cracker to accompany their Christmas dinner, which we like to do every year. And finally we were asked for £400 to buy Caterpillars a new audio system with wireless headphones so they could enjoy stories and songs.

This term we are funding a first aid course for the whole school, so all children at some point will gain valuable information that could save a life. We are glad we are able to help the children to learn this fantastic life skill.

We are immensely proud of what we have been able to purchase for the school - items that are making a big difference to the school life of our children.

PROFIT FROM LAST TERMS' EVENTS

We had a busy first term with lots of events for your children to enjoy. Thank you to everyone that helped - they simply wouldn't run if we did not have the support of the parents.

<u>Family Portraits</u>: Thank you to all of those who booked slots with the photographer. We are still waiting to hear how much money your orders have raised.

<u>KS2 Disco:</u> As popular as ever for our KS2 children and we hope the Year 3 children who attended their first disco had a good time. £670 was raised for the school.

<u>Ugly Bug Ball</u>: The first time we have run this event and it was brilliant with lots of people dressing up. We raised £313 so thank you to those who attended.

<u>Film Night:</u> We held two film nights last term and were able to showcase our fabulous sound system. We also have a new popcorn machine which went down a storm. These film nights raised £390.

<u>Christmas Bazaar</u>: A lot goes in to organising the bazaar, so again a massive thank you to helpers. Also thank you if you came along to support the school, we hope the children enjoyed it. This event raised $\pounds 1,190$.

<u>Tea with Santa for FS and KS1</u>: Thank you to all the helpers who were able to make this event possible – tickets for this sold out in 11 minutes! All children who wanted to attend were however accommodated. We raised £560.

<u>Christmas card orders</u>: We hope your friends and family enjoyed their Christmas cards. We raised a fantastic £812 from your orders.

This is a great night out for adults only. No tickets will be available on the night and tables are selling fast. Please get your table request in by Friday 29th January – tickets are £7 per person which includes a sausage and chip supper.

Friday 12th February – Tag Day

Your child may come to school wearing their own clothes in exchange for a monetary donation. This year we are raising money for our library. Whatever is raised will be matched by the PTFA to help restock our library. The demands of the New Curriculum means lots of new books are needed.
